

HAVE / HAVE GOT

Level

Basic

Language practiced

Grammar: have, have got, in positive, negative and interrogative forms.

Materials

A copy of the cards per small groups.

How it works

Divide the class into small groups. Give each group a set of cards. Tell them to put the cards facing downwards. They should take it into turns to pick up a card and form a sentence.

- If their card has "have" on it: with have
- If their card has "have got": with have got.
- If their card has a +: a positive sentence.
- If their card has a -: a negative sentence.
- If their card has a ?: an interrogative sentence.
- They are always given the object (what they have/have got).

If they have to form a question, they have to ask it to another student in their group, who should then answer back.

HAVE - GREEN EYES	HAVE GOT - FIVE BROTHERS
HAVE + A BLUE CAR	HAVE GOT + A HEADACHE
HAVE ? AN APARTMENT	HAVE GOT ? ANY CHILDREN
HAVE - ANY PROBLEMS	HAVE GOT - A GARDEN
HAVE + MANY FRIENDS	HAVE GOT + THREE DOGS AND SIX CATS
HAVE ? A CUP OF COFFEE EVERY MORNING	HAVE GOT ? A PINK JACKET
